

[Fixed] Bing Desktop Files Corrupt Causing Lots of Other Problems

[Bing Desktop Files Corrupt Causing](#) Lots of Other Problems: Bing is a popular web search engine owned and powered by Microsoft. Previously it was known as MSN and Live Search. Bing Desktop is a free tool by Microsoft which adds the Bing Search box to your desktop.

It can also set your wallpaper, which is in sync with Bing's one. However, with the convenience of Bing's Search on your desktop, there is a standard error of corrupt files for Bing Desktop that causes a lot of other problems.

Solutions for Bing Desktop Files Corrupt Causing Lots of Other Problems

This issue is a big hassle and frustrates the user. Here we provide two potential methods that try to solve this issue.

Method One

This issue is mostly caused by damaged files that need to be repaired. You can run the System File Checker (SFC) scan, which will help to discover and fix corrupted system files for Bing desktop. The following are its steps.

1. Open command prompt by clicking Windows + R and then typing in cmd and then pressing Enter
2. First type this 'DISM.exe /Online /Cleanup-image /Restore health'
3. This can take a while, so let it complete
4. Now perform the SFC scan by typing in the following command 'SFC/ scan now'
5. After the scan is finished, relevant information regarding corrupted or missing system files will appear.

Method Two

Another way to tackle this situation for fix corrupted system files for Bing desktop is to run a Clean Boot. It helps to find out if any third-party application is causing the problem. The following are its steps.

1. In the search box, type 'ms config' and select System Configuration
2. On the services tab, select 'Hide all Microsoft Services' and then click Disable all
3. Open Task Manager and in the startup menu, select every item and disable them all.
